1 次の英文は、中学生の絵実 (Emi) が英語の授業で書いた作文である。これを読んで、問い (1)~(8) に答えよ。(20点)

I'm a member of the volunteer club. We do volunteer work after school. For example, we clean our town and sing some songs with *elderly people living in our town. We also write *articles for our club *newspaper about our volunteer work. Especially I'm interested in helping people in *developing countries. I've never ①(visit) any one of these countries, but I want to help people living in such countries. We collect things like clothes and *shoes. We also collect money in front of the station and at our school. There are many children who don't have enough food in those countries. Most of ②(them) can't go to school. The money and things we collect are used for such children.

Last week, a woman called Ms. Uno came to our school. She told her story to the members of the volunteer club. She's a member of a group helping people in developing countries. Her group sends the money and things we collect to them. She said, "It's important to send money and things to help people in developing countries. It's also important to talk with people who need help." Ms. Uno worked with members of her group in one of the developing countries for three years. 【 A 】 Each member had *expert knowledge of their jobs. When she met people there, she heard that ③[(ア) sent / (イ) helped / (ウ) the money and things / (エ) from Japan / (オ) them]. She felt happy to hear that and wanted to find good ways to make their lives better. She worked hard to understand how people lived there.

One day, when Ms. Uno went to a *field in a village, she met a boy who lived near the field. He couldn't go to school because he had to help his family. 【 B 】 For example, he had to *grow *vegetables for his family. Ms. Uno wanted to help the boy and said to him, "You need to grow vegetables, right? I want to find a good way to do that with you. What can I do for you?" However, he didn't try to talk with her because he didn't believe her. She wanted him to know more about her and ④(spend) a lot of time with him. Then they began to talk to each other. She found something that he wanted to do. He wanted to grow vegetables that he could *keep for a long time. He didn't know how to do that because he couldn't get any *information about it. He asked her about the ways to grow such vegetables well.

First, Ms. Uno tried to find the things which she could do for the boy. She read some books and learned what vegetables he could grow in his field, but the books didn't say how to grow them. Then she went to see a man who was a member of her group. He had expert knowledge about growing those kinds of vegetables. 【 C 】 She and the boy grew the vegetables that he wanted together. He learned how to grow them well and grew a lot of them. Sometimes he could get many vegetables and sell some of them. His life became better than before.

Ms. Uno said to the members of our volunteer club, "The boy looked happy when he was able to grow the vegetables that he wanted. I'll never forget his *smile. At first, I couldn't really understand ⑤(his problem), but I understood it by talking with him. I was able to tell the boy and his family how to grow the vegetables well and it made their life better. 【 D 】 Like this, I talked with other people in his village and found the things they needed. Now, I want to give children like him a chance to go to school."

I learned there are things we do not understand just by sending money and things. It's important for us to understand what people in developing countries are thinking. Ms. Uno talked with people who lived in the village. She understood what they were thinking and found what to do for them. I'm going to write an article for our club newspaper about the things I learned from my experience. I want many students to know about them and to join us. I think I have to understand how people in developing countries live there. To do that, I want to go to such countries in the future and talk with people there like Ms. Uno.

Rob: Look! This menu is written in English.

 Ken: Right. Also, it says that they can ask questions about the menu. That means people working in this restaurant can speak English, right?
 Rob: I'm sure they can. Now, what are we going to eat?
 Ken: Maybe I'm going to order a *dish made with *bread. I don't want to eat spaghetti or pizza.
 Rob: Well, then, you can choose one of these two dishes. Each one is three hundred *yen.
 Ken: I don't want to eat egg today, I'll choose the other one. Look! We can choose a bigger size. I want that one because I'm hungry.
 Rob: OK. I'm going to eat spaghetti or pizza. Which should I choose? I saw their pictures at the front door of this restaurant, and those two dishes looked good that I can't decide.
 Ken: Here, it says that you can eat tomatoes which are picked in this town if you choose spaghetti.
 Rob: Right! That's great! I'll choose the bigger size of that, and then I don't need a salad.
 Ken: What do you want to drink?
 Rob: I like apple juice. Apples are my favorite fruit. Is there apple juice on this menu?
 Ken: No. The only fruit juice is orange juice, but you can eat apple pie. Do you want it?
 Rob: Oh! Yes. I'll have that too, and I'd like some tea with it. How about you?
 Ken: I need a salad and a *drink. Maybe orange juice. That's all that I'm going to eat and drink.
